Proposed By-Law Changes

Proposed By-Law Changes (To be voted on at Fall Meeting Nov. 5th)

Current By-Law - Article IV Elections = Section 6: “ To be elected to the office of President, he/she must have held a previously elected position on the Washington JCI Senate BOD.”

Suggested change – “To be elected to the office of President, he/she must have been a Washington Senator for 1 Year.”

Current By-Law -Article IV Elections = Section 4: “The new Board of directors shall take office immediately upon the adjournment of the meeting at which they are elected.”

(Note: There is no way this can be done. When changing Treasurer, the new and the old have to meet at the bank, and complete signature cards, and other forms. The secretary would have to complete the minutes which include the election of the new Treasurer, to show the bank for authorization, hence, ‘immediately’ is the wrong term).

Suggested change – “The new Board of directors shall take office within 2 weeks of being elected.”

Current By-Law - Article IV Elections = Section 1: “The President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer of this Corporation shall be elected by a majority vote of the membership of this corporation at the Annual Meeting of the membership. The elected officers of the Board shall serve for a term of 1 year.”

Suggested change – “The elected officers of the Board shall serve for a term of 2 years.”

Policies Government Section 1. “The Board of Directors shall submit a proposed plan and budget at the Fall Board for membership approval. Said budget shall carry a line item for the cost of 1 room for the outgoing President at the Annual Meeting.”

Suggest to add- “pending available funds”.

Duties/Officers (3) – “All books, funds, and supplies belonging to the Washington JCI Senate , shall be relinquished to the new officers by the retiring officers immediately upon leaving office.”

Suggest change – “within 2 weeks after elections.”

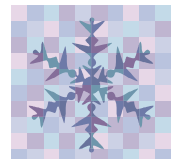
