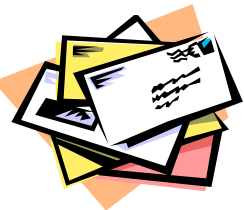

## THOSE PESKY WHITE FLAKES ON OUR SHIRT COLLARS



Dandruff is a common scalp condition that occurs when dead skin is shed, producing irritating white flakes. It is usually a condition of oily, rather than dry, skin, and occurs as skin cells renew themselves and the old cells are shed.

Some people tend to generate and discard skin cells at a faster rate than others. Recent research shows that severe cases of flaking scalp, usually associated with seborrhea (a type of dermatitis), may be caused by an overgrowth of the yeast *Pityrosporum ovale*, which lives naturally on the skin.

Dandruff can be triggered by trauma, illness, hormonal imbalances, improper carbohydrate consumption, and the consumption of sugar. Deficiencies of nutrients such as the B-complex vitamins, es-

sential fatty acids, and selenium have been linked to dandruff as well. Dandruff is normally worse in the winter months.

Dandruff is an annoying and embarrassing problem, but is rarely serious. There is no cure for dandruff, but the condition can be minimized.

### Helpful Nutrients

Flaxseed oil, primrose oil or salmon oil. These help to relieve itching and inflammation essential for health skin and scalp.

Kelp—1,000-15,00 mg daily—Supplies needed minerals, especially iodine, for better hair growth and healing of the scalp.

Selenium—200 mcg daily—but no more than 40 mcg if pregnant - Antioxidant to aid in controlling dry scalp.

Vitamin B complex—100 mg twice daily—necessary for healthy skin & hair.

Other recommendations:

\* Eat a diet consisting of 50-75 % raw foods. Eat soured products such as yogurt.

\* Avoid fried foods, dairy products, sugar, flour, chocolate, nuts and seafood.

\* Try rinsing your hair with vinegar and water instead of plain water after shampooing.

# SOME INTERESTING HOME REMEDIES

Arthritis—most of us have it or will have it someday. It is the oldest known ailment on earth. Here are some common sense ways to help:

Loose weight & gain relief.

Stretch gently for strength and to maintain joint mobility.

Find relief through less stress. Don't race — pace yourself. Learn to relax.

Try P.M. prevention for A.M. stiffness. The application of a muscle ointment at night before going to bed helps to relax you and gives you a psychological boost as well.

Float away pain. Studies have shown that floating in specially designed flotation tanks, also known as isolation or sensory deprivation tanks can relieve

arthritic pain.

Work wonders with watercise. Your pain will be significantly reduced in the water and you become much more flexible in water then you are in air.

Use ice to prevent pain. The use of cold packs for those times when a joint has been stressed from overuse or overwork. On for 15-20 minutes, off for 15-20 minutes, and repeat cycle. This can be repeated over several hours to reduce joint pain.

Use heat to reduce pain. When joints become swollen, hot and or tender, use heat to reduce the inflammation and pain.

Boost Vitamin C intake.

Improve intake of oils rich in Omega-3s.

Carrot juice, celery juice, cabbage juice

Caption describing picture or tomato juice can be beneficial for some.

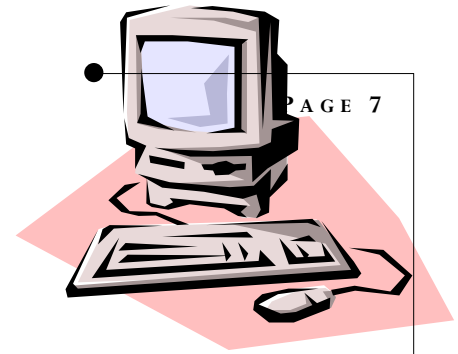
Massage of those muscles that are attached to the tendons leading to your painful joints.

Fish Oil. Some people respond to fish oil by improving patient's joint tenderness and fatigue.
