HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

(Reprint from US JCE Senate E-News #2017 – 04)

DID YOU KNOW - "When JCI first offered the JCI Senatorship program to each JCI member country, it was a profit making project for JCI, then badly in need of operating cash. Initially, the cost of a Senatorship was US \$50, and the goal was to sell 1,000 such Senatorships worldwide. Many who had been and who were active, especially on the national and international levels, bought their own Senatorships, thus enabling JCI to pay daily operating costs, and eventually, they accumulated sufficient funds to acquire their own headquarters office building. However, it took 5 years to reach their initial goal, and JCI Senate #1000 was awarded on May 10, 1957, to then thirty-nine year old Robert E. (Bob) Feller of Cleveland, Ohio, famous baseball pitcher for the Cleveland Indians, and originally from Van Meter, lowa."
