HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

(Reprint from US JCE Senate E-News #2017 – 06)

DID YOU KNOW – One of the purposes upon which the US JCI Senate was founded on was to provide assistance to the Junior Chamber “when asked”. This assistance was provided on a more or less informal basis until 1987. That year, under President Larry Sheeler #16232, the US JCI Senate developed the “Yes We Can Help” program. The name was an offshoot of US Jaycee President Gary Wilkinson’s theme: “Yes We Can.”

Mike Harris #24801 from North Carolina, was selected to run the program, which was renamed “Return the Favor” later that year. The program has been a US JCI Senate mainstay ever since. Under Return the Favor, individual Senators, State, and Region Senate organizations have been encouraged to adopt programs to help the Jaycees and are recognized at year end.

In 1994, the US Jaycees, under President Matt Shapiro, began recognizing Senators who did an outstanding job providing assistance to the Jaycees.

In 2001, Return the Favor chairman Jim Calder #5514, a two time RTF Award winner, expanded the program – first formalizing the procedures for nominating and evaluating Return the Favor nominees. These procedures have been slightly revised in the years since.

Our bid will not be approved until the January Board meeting in Houston, Texas on January 12-15, 2017, after the National Administrative VP does the hotel inspection in November.

2 – Manpower: We will need help with hospitality, setting up tours, etc. We can discuss this more at the January meeting.

We will also need to have a contingent present at the National Convention in June in Chicago as well. Registration forms for the January meeting are being attached in this newsletter.

4 – Ideas!! My brain is pretty fried from all the wedding stuff this year, and we need a theme!! This I need before we go to Houston so we can print up the registration forms and raffle tickets, and maybe even order/sell shirts.

TREASURER'S REPORT



My fellow Senators,

I just wrapped up a meeting with our investment broker at Edward Jones. Our investment accounts have performed quite well over the past few years. We have the funds balanced in a way that has taken advantage of the low interest rates and the stock market increases. During the discussion with our broker, we talked about several things including the national debt, the fact that interest rates have currently remained low, and how our investment accounts are allocated amongst different stocks and bonds. We also talked about the news that the rates are due for a hike. This hike probably will not happen until after the election, but we were advised to do some load balancing in how the assets are allocated. I took their advice to move a small percentage of the money into funds that are currently performing well, but traditionally will weather a rise in interest rates better than we have today. These actions did not change the dollar values of the investment accounts, just on how they are invested. I will continue to monitor how this change impacts these accounts and keep you informed.

One of the things that we discussed at our last meeting was the need to balance out the monies between the accounts. Our fundraisers are not meeting the current expenses of the organization, so we will need to take some of the earnings from the Lifetime account to do this. Although this account has increased in value as well, the earnings would be greater if we added to the base amount. Additionally, our Seattle 77 account will be used early next year for seed money when we host the national convention in September 2017.

At the last meeting, we had an open discussion about the possibility of moving some of the proceeds around between the three accounts. I did not want to have a motion/vote at that time to approve the rebalancing. Instead, I wanted to give you the chance to attend our next meeting to listen and give your opinion. **Please keep your calendars open for January 28, 2017 and plan to attend the Winter Board Meeting in Ellensburg, WA.**

Also, I reported that the 2015 taxes have been filed, so our 501(c)3 status is current. This means that you can donate any unused money that you happen to have laying around to the Senate. We would be happy to help you by taking that burden off of your hands.

Thank you for allowing me to serve as your Treasurer this year. I look forward to your questions and discussions when we meet again.
